Recommendation for School Library Books

Background Information

In accordance with Texas Education Code §33.021 and the requirements outlined in SB 13, Weatherford ISD established a School Library Advisory Committee (SLAC) to review proposed library materials prior to Board consideration. The SLAC process ensures all recommended books meet state and local standards for age appropriateness, educational value, and alignment with community expectations.

On January 22, 2026, the School Library Advisory Committee convened to review new book titles proposed for to be purchased to be included in district libraries. The committee reviewed each title based on content and alignment with district collection development guidelines, ensuring all selections comply with legislative and TEA guidance.

Following the review and discussion, the committee unanimously voted to recommend the listed books for Board of Trustees approval.
