
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

















CHALLENGES

- Shipping delays
- Operating 7-days a week with a 5-day a week crew
- Recruitment: (pay scale for NSBSD maintenance workers v NSB Maintenance or Public Works) and competitive salaries for tradespeople, cooks, and bus drivers

- Budget challenges
 - Prioritizing infrastructure needs and operational items
 - Prioritizing work orders and outstanding operational items
- Inventory (Nutrition Services and M&O)
- Change in M&O philosophy and management
 - Changing peoples' attitudes and perception of M&O
 - Changing priorities according to the Strategic Plan
