TITLE: **Study of Menu of Statewide Assessments and Authorization to Pilot ACT Option**

BACKGROUND:

Arizona Department of Education allows school districts to administer an approved assessment in place of AzMERIT and AIMS Science. The current list of assessments are:

- ACT
- SAT
- Advanced Placement (AP)
- International Baccalaureate (IB)
- Cambridge

We are required to submit notification to the Board and to ADE by July 1st as to which test we will administer. With Board approval of this item, we will be piloting ACT in the late spring of 2019. The goal is for state funding to be in place for at least the 2019-2020 school year to help with the cost of the assessments.

A presentation will provide additional information and details regarding this assessment option.

RECOMMENDATION:


The Administration recommends that the Governing Board study and discuss the Menu of Assessments and authorize the Pilot of ACT Option.
