NSBSD Policy Manual:

Board Bylaw 9311, Board Policies:...Prior to adoption, policies shall normally be given two readings by the Board. At its second reading, the policy may be adopted by a majority vote of all members of the Board.

Board Bylaw 9313 Administrative Regulations: The Superintendent or designee shall develop administrative regulations when required by law or Board policy or when, in his/her judgement, Board endorsement of district procedures is desired.

This policy, administrative regulation, and exhibits are designed to protect students from inappropriate adult behaviors that clearly identifies behaviors and corrective actions to assist the District in its responsibilities to care for students.
