As a third year music teacher in Harvey School District #152, I would benefit tremendously by attending the 2013 Illinois Music Education Conference in Peoria, Illinois from January 23 to 26, 2012. At the event, there are several opportunities for me to develop professionally and increase my effectiveness as a music classroom teacher.

These opportunities include approximately 100 clinics and workshops, each of which offers Continuing Professional Development Units (CPDUs) towards recertification. There are dozens of concerts by reputable Illinois school ensembles of all ages which model an approach to providing musical opportunities to students who show talent and desire to perform. Through this, I will see how I can continue to grow ensembles I have started in Harvey schools that will teach effectively and allow students the chance to perform.

There are also music "reading sessions" where newly composed music, curricula, and other teaching resources are handed out for free and overviewed by the people who wrote and designed them. This will not only be a great opportunity for me to be exposed to new ideas and methods, but also to hear them be presented directly from the source of their authors.

Beginning Thursday and ending Sunday, there will be an exhibit in the Peoria Civic Center's Exhibition Hall. Here, there are 612 booths assembled which contain more resources, music, and instruments. This will continue to expose me to other ideas and new materials.

The Conference is attended by thousands of music educators in the state of Illinois, and it is an incredible opportunity for networking. Throughout the whole weekend, I will be attending these clinics, reading sessions, performances, and exhibits alongside several other individuals with whom I can discuss ideas, methods, and other creative ways to be effective in the music classroom. I attended this conference last year and am currently implementing methods I learned from clinics and reading sessions. I maintain frequent contact with colleagues I met last year to brainstorm ideas that will improve my effectiveness in the classroom. These are only a few examples of what is to be gained by attending the 2013 Illinois Music Education Conference.
