1. Ranger Ready Metrics -
 - a. There has been a LOT of good work happening around our Ranger Ready program
 - i. **Reminder:** This program involves our Ranger Career Pathways, Profile of a Ranger Graduate, and our Redefining Ready Metrics.

2. Youth Skills Grant -
 - a. We were one of a handful of districts in Region 5 that were a part of the Youth Skills Training grant. Though funding is running out at the end of this year, I wanted to highlight all of the good that came from that grant.
 - i. CNA - 4 students were able to earn the CNA license as a part of their school day, while at the same time earning high school credits
 - ii. CDL - 5 of our high school seniors have completed the classroom portion of the CDL program and can now move forward with getting their CDL.
 - iii. CPR/First Aid Trainer Certification - Two of our staff members have received the training needed to teach CPR/First Aid to our students and staff. This will allow students to earn the certification as a part of the Health Career Occupations class and potentially others.
 - b. We are exploring other options for continuing with the CNA opportunity for our students and will hopefully have more information soon.
