## Attention 11th Graders! State Testing Information

Our 11th grade students will participate in Oregon's required state assessments at the end of March and beginning of April. These tests are an important opportunity for students to demonstrate the skills and knowledge they have developed throughout their academic journey and can play a meaningful role in graduation pathways and postsecondary readiness.

We want students to take this assessment seriously and do their very best. Performing well helps ensure that each student's academic record accurately reflects their abilities and keeps future options open.

To support our Juniors, the school is actively preparing students for success. In the weeks leading up to the assessment, 11th graders are engaging in targeted practice problems during Advisory. These sessions are designed to build familiarity with the test format, strengthen key skills, and increase confidence before testing begins.

Families can support students by encouraging consistent attendance, adequate rest, and a positive mindset as testing approaches. Together, we are working to ensure every 11th grader feels prepared, supported, and ready to show what they know.

**Overall Regular Attender Rate: 67% (up by 3%)**


## Battle of the Bookaneers!

## Attendance Matters!

### Oregon Law: ORS 339.010

- All children between the ages of 6 and 18 years who have no completed the 12th grades are required to attend regularly a public full-time school during the entire school term.
- Students are considered irregular attenders when they meet any of the following:
  - 8 unexcused one half days absences in any four week period
  - 5 absences (excused or unexcused) in three months
  - 10 absences (excused or unexcused) in 6 months
- Chronic absences means missing 10% or more school days in a year for ANY reason. That is nearly a month of school. **Chronic absenteeism includes ALL absences, consecutive or not, excused or not, as they all relate to a student's overall attendance.**


## Tutoring Information
