INSTRUCTION - GRANTING CREDIT FOR HOME SCHOOL WORK

Credit for coursework completed in a non-accredited home school setting shall be granted when all of the following conditions have been met.

- 1. The home school student's parents have completed all of the state mandated home school reporting requirements.
- 2. A portfolio of the home school student's work completed has been submitted for each subject for which credit is sought.
- 3. The home school student has satisfactorily completed a district-administered test that measures student achievement in academic subject areas.

The amount of credit granted for the work completed shall be determined by Independent School District No. 31 school officials.

Grades from other schools or institutions do not count toward a student's grade point average or class rank at Bemidji High School.

Students must be enrolled in Bemidji Area Schools during the semester in which graduation occurs in order to receive a Bemidji High School diploma.
