We have completed the review of the quotations received on March 9, 2010 for the Churchill High School HVAC Equipment, and recommendation to pre-order Trane HVAC Equipment per the attached proposal. We and IDS have met with both manufacturers to review scope of the equipment (see IDS's attached recommendation letter) and feel that due to the districts past success with Trane on service and maintenance that over the life of the equipment, the Trane product would be more cost effective.

The equipment takes 10 weeks from the time the order is placed, to the time the equipment arrives on site. Due to this length of time required to manufacturer the equipment and the need to have the units on site the week of June 21<sup>st</sup>, 2010 to allow us to meet the schedule, we feel it is necessary to pre-order the equipment prior to the bidding and award of the balance of the project. The prices for the HVAC equipment are within the budget previously presented.
