The Student Services department has been working to replace existing materials and provide digital licenses in support of the approved Rock Island-Milan School District curriculum.

The digital components are the online teacher and/or student access to the curriculum as well as intervention materials for reading.

**Reading Mastery Transformations:**

- Teacher Materials: \$1,504.23
- Student Materials K-5: \$150, 718

Reading Mastery Transformations provides direct reading instruction. Literacy outcomes increase through the use of explicit, systematic instruction. Reading Mastery Transformations is the only true Direct Instruction based curriculum built to support both core instruction and targeted interventions. The Science of Reading approach equips teachers to meet the unique needs of each learner.

**ALEKS Renewal (Non-Public Proportionate Share Services)**

- 50 ten-month student subscriptions
- 4 ten-month teacher subscriptions
- Jordan Catholic School: \$2,346.00

The ALEKS renewal provides adaptive, individualized math instruction for eligible students attending non-public schools. This supports the district's obligation to provide equitable services through proportionate share under federal guidelines.

It is recommended that the Board of Education approve the purchase of curriculum materials and digital licenses at a total cost not to exceed \$200,000 from McGraw Hill LLC, PO Box 182605 Columbus, Ohio 43218.
