D.	<b>Summary:</b> Robstown ISD has opted into the Texas Education Agency's program for free COVID-19 testing. TEA will provide testing kits as well as the required PPE to conduct the testing. The tests are BinaxNOW rapid antigen tests that provide results in 15 minutes. According to an evaluation conducted by Abbott, when evaluating individuals who had COVID-19 symptoms for less than 7 days, there was a true positive rate of 97.1% and a true negative rate of 98.5% when compared to PCR testing.
	To participate in this program, we had to certify that:
