#### c) MEETS 3 OUT OF 4 OF THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

Student Portfolio 95 CogAT 95% ile

≥ 95% ile or Level III Achievement Test-Reading Achievement Test-Math > 95% ile or Level III

#### d) MEETS ALL OF THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

Performs at a remarkably high level on the Gifted Opportunities Profile (GOP)

#### Identification for Gifted/Talented Services in Junior High School Middle School Programs:

Students may receive G/T identification in the area of their strength, English, Social Studies, Math, Science, or in all four disciplines. Effective 2018-2019: Students are required to successfully meet expectations on STAAR annually to continue GT services in their specific identified content area.
