**Re:** Course Elimination: Health Information Technology

I respectfully recommend removing the semester-long, unweighted course Health Information Technology from the course offerings for the 2027-2028 school year.

The elimination of Health Information Technology is part of a strategic effort to modernize the Health Sciences Pathway by aligning the curriculum with current industry standards and student analytics. By removing this course, the district can prioritize a recommended sequence of study that focuses on high-demand healthcare roles, advanced certifications and dual credit opportunities. This revision creates space for new, targeted course options that offer students a more direct and efficient trajectory toward their chosen medical careers.
