**I. Principal's Report** (5 min): Fantastic job on a great start to the school year. Dawn, Maggie, Lisa and Venessa did a ton of work getting the school ready and getting organized.

- J. Administrative Reports
  - 1. Lead Teacher (10 min):
    - a. Curriculum: New Math curriculum for 6<sup>th</sup> grade "Go Math". Excited about the new curriculum. Using the old curriculum for the elementary until next year. Trying to get everyone up to grade level before the end of the school year.
    - Division of Labor: Maggie teaches, 2<sup>nd</sup> 5<sup>th</sup> grade. Dawn teaches 6<sup>th</sup> 12<sup>th</sup> grade. Maggie is teacher of record for K-1.
    - c. Research Volleyball: Dawn will see who is interested.
    - d. Greenhouse: Elementary dug out about 65 pounds of potatoes. Each student took home a five pound bag of potatoes. Kids have planted seeds. Elementary school is doing the daily data collection in the greenhouse. We found some aphids but are working hard at getting rid of them. Middle and high school are doing the weekly and monthly maintenance in the greenhouse. Chickens are about to be ordered. Rabbits may have to wait until Spring.
    - e. Facebook: Lisa has taken it on and has been updating that. New pics of cross-country are posted. Nice job Lisa.
    - f. Utilities: Working on ensuring that lights are turned off when not in use. Copy machine and closing windows.
    - g. Respect: going to start passing out "caught you being awesome" certificates.

  - Sports (5 min): Cross country: All the kids did really well. Next week is Craig and then Thorne Bay.
