

- Students missing 10-19% of school year
- Provide Support Services
- Family Meetings
- Home Visits
- Attendance Contracts




INTENSE STRATEGIES

- Students missing 20% or more of the current school year
- Intensive case management with Juvenile Case Manager
- Criminal Complaint Filed if necessary

CAMPUS STRATEGIES THAT ENCOURAGE SCHOOL ATTENDANCE

- Available to all Students
- Miss less than 10% of school year
- Recognize good and improved attendance
- Educate & engage families
- Clarify attendance expectations
- Establish a positive and engaging school climate

STUDENT ATTENDANCE PROTOCOLS

Teacher Contact

Teacher will call parent/guardian via telephone once the student reaches 2nd unexcused absence.

Campus Administration

Warning Notice and Attendance Contract may be issued once student reaches 3 or more unexcused absences within a 4 week period.

Campus Administration & Attendance Advocate

7 or more unexcused absences
Campus Administrator will meet with parent/guardian to discuss attendance and have parent sign the Warning Notice and Attendance Contract. If no improvement, Campus will contact Attendance Advocate for Home Visit.

Attendance Advocate & Juvenile Case Manager

10 or more unexcused absences
If unexcused absences continue, parent/guardian will be summoned for a School Based Contract with Juvenile Case Manager or to a Mediation docket depending on severity of absences. Loss of Credit warning letter will be sent to high school students.

Municipal Court


15 or more unexcused absences
If unexcused absences continue, Attendance Advocates will file a criminal complaint against parent/guardian at the Municipal Court.

ATTENDANCE ADVOCATES DATA - RAAWEE



- **Four Attendance Advocate manage 4-5 campuses each (2 more than last year)**
- **3,375 Warning Notices issued (752 more than last year)**
- **2,063 Attendance Contracts done (1,457 more than last year)**
- **1,608 Home visits done by Attendance Advocates (895 more than last year)**
- **233 Families were invited to a School-based contract (Campus based)**
- **640 Families were invited to Court Mediations (Municipal Courthouse - 10 dates)**
- **74 Criminal complaints have been accepted (84 submitted)**
- **1,314 Loss of Credit Letters issued**
