# **BOARD CONSTRAINT EXAMPLES**

#### \*Pick 3/4

## **BOARD CONSTRAINT 1**

Board shall not engage in negative conversations that put administrators, or staff in a negative manner or light.

#### **BOARD CONSTRAINT 2**

Board shall manage time in a board meeting wisely by spending the majority of time focused on goals and priorities.

#### **BOARD CONSTRAINT 3**

Board or any individual board member shall not publicly, criticize any decisions made by the body corporate or administration.

#### **BOARD CONSTRAINT 4**

Board shall listen to community concerns, but not give or appear to give personal opinions and will direct community member to contact the appropriate person.

#### **BOARD CONSTRAINT 5**

The Board will not deviate from the Board's operating procedures, particularly related to the protocol of communication.

#### **BOARD CONSTRAINT 6**

The Board will not get distracted from investing at least 50% of its time each month on setting/monitoring its student outcome goals.

#### **BOARD CONSTRAINT 7**

The Board, either collectively or through the actions of individual Board members, shall not: spend less than 50% of time during board authorized public meetings focused on student outcomes.

### **BOARD CONSTRAINT 8**

The Board, either collectively or through the actions of individual Board members, shall not: give or appear to give operational advice or instructions to district staff.

#### **BOARD CONSTRAINT 9**

The Board, either collectively or through the actions of individual Board members, shall not: behave in a manner that erodes trust and respect among the team of 8.

# **Superintendent's Constraints**

- C1. Do not allow the collaborative partnership between home, school, and community to deteriorate.
- C2. Do not allow the District to be fiscally unsound.
- C3. Do not allow adult convenience or preference to take priority over the academic progress of our students.
