## **Facilities Committee**

The Facilities Committee met on the 21st of February. I have attached the minutes from that meeting. The next meeting is TBD.

#### School Update

The school is really starting to take shape. The second floor classrooms are pretty much completed. The only thing left to do is put in the extra storage cabinets. The restrooms are all but finished upstairs. They will finish up painting the corridor walls and then start tiling the hallway. It will not be long and the first floor will look the same. The gym floor is set to be installed on March 11<sup>th</sup>.

## **High School Roof Project**

I received three quotes for the roof project, with Dura-Last being the lowest. The Committee and myself, are recommending that we approve the bid from Dura-Last, with Tingley Roofing as the Contractor.

This will cost the District \$500 per day, with 80% being reimbursed in the following year over four payments from the State, through the Transportation Report. I would like the Board to please consider this and approve it. We are already working with limited drivers and cannot afford to lose anymore.
