2. Background:

Uvalde CISD continues to strengthen and understand Career and Technical Education (CTE) as a core lever for student engagement, workforce readiness, and CCMR outcomes. CTE pathways provide students with industry-aligned coursework, certifications, and postsecondary opportunities that support both immediate workforce entry and continued education.

3. Process:

UCISD partnered with Region 20 Education Service Center and Southwest Texas College (SWTC) to review the current state of Welding, Agricultural Mechanics Technology, and Dual Credit programming. This collaboration examines program alignment, entity standards, and postsecondary pathways to strengthen Career and Technical Education opportunities for students. The presentation provides the Board of Trustees with an overview of current programs and the ongoing collaboration between UCISD, Region 20, TEA and SWTC.
