Subject: ESL/Emergent Bilingual Program Evaluation Report

Background Information:

In accordance with the Texas Education Code (TEC) §29.053 and Texas Administrative Code Chapter 89, districts are required to evaluate their Emergent Bilingual (EB) programs annually and present findings to the Board of Trustees and to the Texas Education Agency (TEA).

The presentation will provide an update on Graham ISD's Bilingual/English as a Second Language (ESL) program. Trustees will receive information related to criteria for entrance into the program, the extent to which students are becoming proficient in English, state assessment data, reclassification history of the students, teacher professional learning, and a description of our parental involvement activities.

Administrative Consideration:

We currently serve 278 students in our English as a Second Language (ESL)/Bilingual programs. The majority of these students are served in our elementary schools. Our Emergent Bilingual students speak 3 different languages: Spanish (99%), Gujarati, and Vietnamese.
