651 CROSSLAKE COMMUNITY SCHOOLS (CCS) ONLINE WELL-CHILD CHECK POLICY

I. PURPOSE

To ensure the safety and well-being of all Crosslake Community Schools (CCS) Online students when all attempts at communication and engagement have been exhausted. This policy establishes the official action CCS Online will take as a last resort when a student is deemed unresponsive and potentially at risk.

II. POLICY STATEMENT

Crosslake Community Schools (CCS) Online is committed to the safety and well-being of its students as its highest priority. A request for a Well-Child Check is a safety-driven measure of last resort, to be employed only after staff has made multiple, documented attempts to re-establish contact and engagement with an unresponsive student and their family.

1. **Safety Priority:** CCS Online can initiate contact with local law enforcement to request a Well-Child Check when a student and parent/guardian have been unresponsive and all standard outreach protocols have been followed and documented.
2. **Last Resort:** This action will only be taken when a lack of communication raises a reasonable concern for the student's safety.
3. **Required Documentation:** All staff outreach attempts and the subsequent request to law enforcement must be formally documented in the student's file, including any follow-up information or outcomes.
