## **NSBSD Policy Manual:**

BP 3312, Contracts: The Superintendent or designee may enter into contracts and memoranda of agreement on behalf of the district. All contracts and memorandums of agreement with a dollar value of \$10,000 or greater must be approved by the School Board.

### **Issue Summary:**

Partnow Consulting is owned and operated by Patricia (Pat) Partnow. Pat will support the Iñupiaq Education Department management of the Mapkug program by: overseeing the assignment and copyrights of all books written for the Mapkuq program; assist in publishing electronic versions of Mapkug curriculum; assist in the transition of Mapkug curriculum from Rubicon Atlas to Chalk; identify gaps of curriculum in culture-based units; mentor teachers in the production of Mapkuq curriculum; research and write new guides for materials produced in FY24; provide professional development of the mapkug program to new teachers and Mapkug curriculum developers; and teach self-support credit courses to teachers on culturally responsive curriculum and curriculum design. Pat has worked with the District and the Iñupiaq Education Department since 2003, and was a contractor this past school year supporting the work and initiatives in the Iñupiaq Education Department. She has helped with the planning and development of the Iñupiaq Learning Framework, has supported the work within Project Mapkug, has written, published, and created materials, books, and resources for our cultural-based unit kits, and has offered expertise in various content areas in curriculum development. Pat has an all-encompassed understanding and appreciation for the Iñupiaq culture due to her experience with her work in our communities and with our district. She understands the depth of knowledge and multifaceted complexity when it comes to our culture, history, language and traditions.

### **Length of Contract:**

July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024.

## **Funding Source and Purchase/Contract Amount:**

This contract would come out of the Iñupiaq Education Department Professional & Technical budget (Account Code: 100.200.120.000.410) in the amount of and not to exceed \$60,450.00.

## Compliance with BP 3311:

The district has worked with Partnow Consulting since 2003 and through that time contributed to the formation of the Iñupiaq Learning Framework, 22 cultural-based unit kits in all grade levels, helped create our local courses like North Slope History and Culture, North Slope Government, Alaska Studies, and has helped review, align, and vet the over 300 cultural-based units that were developed by our district teachers. Although we can purchase materials and resources written and authored by people and companies elsewhere, we will not receive the same quality materials written by an expert in curriculum writing, Understanding by Design, and someone who has spent decades submersing themselves in our culture, language, history, and traditions. This is a key piece in creating local, place-based curriculum that encompasses stories and concepts that are most relatable and understandable by our students of the NSBSD. Pat will continue to help support the expansion and enhancement of this work as we move forward. She will also support writing teacher guides for implementation on the newly local authored book, "Crane Story II," and the upcoming Early Reader Series, which are both authored by Cathy Tagnak Rexford. She will continue being a mentor and guide for teachers and staff, curriculum writing, and support professional development needs.
