TOPIC: Approval to Purchase Electrostatic Disinfectant Sprayer Machines

RECOMMENDATION:

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District approve the purchase of electrostatic disinfectant sprayer machines from Ferguson Facilities Supply, Belleville, Michigan in the amount of \$71,982.00.

RATIONALE:

The Clorox Total 360 System is an electrostatic sprayer that disinfects the front, back and sides of surfaces. The purchase includes delivery and pricing comes from the National IPA (Intergovernmental Purchasing Alliance), which fulfills the District's bidding requirements. These 18 disinfecting machines will be added to the District's current seven machines so we will have one machine in each building. While the District will fund this purchase from the General Fund, we will seek federal grant funding to reimburse the District, as available and applicable.
