Homecoming	Homecoming week starts on Monday, September 13 th with coronation. The week is full of traditional activities such as sporting events, dress-up days, and other activities. The high school will share information about the week's activities after final adjustments are made.
Veterans Day Program	<p>For many years, Red Wing High School has hosted an annual Veterans Day Program. When asked in August, I initially said it would not be held this year in RWHS because face coverings were not required and there is a significant number of people in attendance at an indoor activity.</p> <p>However, the district now requires face coverings in school buildings, so the event could be held in my opinion, especially if we can physically distance attendees as much as possible.</p> <p>Our contact at the high school will reach out to see if arrangements can still be made.</p>

Purpose of Open Forum	An open forum is planned for September 20 th . I would like to confirm with board members that the sole topic for discussion during the forum relates to planned use for Jefferson School.
Every Hand Joined	Youth Outreach will be taking over work and initiatives previously completed by Every Hand Joined, including the datamart used by the district and community partners. i3Works maintains the datamart, so Youth Outreach will continue to have access like other community partners; Youth Outreach representatives will need parent authorization forms completed before they can access student information. If requested by the board, Youth Outreach can provide an update to the board during an upcoming meeting.
Community Education and Recreation Fall Brochure	The fall brochure for Community Education and Recreation is included as an “extra” for school board meeting.
Non-Public School Consultation	In August, school officials met with representatives of non-public schools in the district to discuss nursing, transportation, special education, Title programs, and other ways we collaborate.
