Remote Special Education Homebound Services

General Questions
1. Give a brief narrative description of the requested waiver.

Denton ISD is requesting a waiver to serve a special education student remotely for homebound services. Due to a diagnosed medical condition, the student's doctor recommends the student to remain at home and to receive remote learning from homebound services. The student will require more than 20 hours of remote conferencing. The student meets the special education remote homebound criteria.

2. Does the district or campus plan reflect the need for this waiver? If yes, what is the specific objective impacted by the waiver?

Yes: Students will demonstrate evidence of mastery of Algebra I by the end of 9th grade.

4. Describe the plan to be implemented, if the waiver is granted.

The special education homebound instructor will meet remotely with the student for at least 4 hours per week. The teacher will assist the student in communicating with teachers on a daily basis. The teacher will also ensure that the student's Individual Education Plan (IEP) is implemented with fidelity. Instruction will be provided synchronously by a special education certified teacher who is not teaching in-person students at the same time. The student meets the criteria for special education remote homebound services.

5. How will granting this waiver help achieve the district's or campus' objective?

The student's IEP will be implemented to ensure mastery of Algebra I by the end of the year and according to the student's IEP.

6. Please explain how the school district or campus will evaluate the impact of the waiver towards meeting the district's or campus' goal.

The campus will evaluate the impact of the waiver through the student's progress on the STAAR Algebra I exam.
