 - a. Surplus of \$108,000 last month. Currently at \$186,000 surplus at the end of May.
- 4. FY20 & FY21 Budget Update
 - a. Positive relationship with Town of Woodbridge
 - b. \$90,000 of current projected surplus will remain with BOE Budget to offset costs due to COVID planning for FY21. Returning remaining \$95,000, plus any additional surplus realized through June, to the town. Many thanks to the town for their ongoing partnership, support, and collaboration.
 - c. Superintendents recommendations on final adjustments to the FY21 zero budget, use of surplus, pre-buying Covid19 items and other areas are still a Draft and not final. Superintendent is listening to all voices and considering many options. Proposals include restoring Library position to full time and restoring new School Psychologist to full time. Also mentioned was the consideration of 0.5 FTE school social worker position. Other items include technology, special education costs related to Individualized Education Plan support hours, Health Insurance, possibly bus monitors, professional development and miscellaneous needs.
