District of Innovation Renewal **Timeline**

August 2021

Upon approval

Initiate process of proposing to become a District of Innovation by identifying provisions currently in place that should be exempted on this plan—Review with Leadership Team.

District functions in accordance with plan and will be exempt from

the Texas Education Code mandates noted in plan.

September 2021 Discuss process of renewal to continue with status of District of Innovation by identifying provisions currently in place that should be exempted on this plan with campus/district administrators at Cabinet Meeting. October12, 2021 Present to the Board of Trustees district's plan to renew DOI status and send letter to Commissioner/TEA (1st required notification). October 14, 2021 Meet with DAC (District Advisory Committee) to identify exemptions include, reviews local district policies affected. November 4, 2021 Meet with DAC to finalize DOI renewal plan. Present to Management and Leadership Team Draft of DOI Plan. December 2, 2021 Finalize details of Innovation Plan with DAC, and vote within DAC. Send policies for attorneys for review. December 15, 2021 Present Plan to Board at Regular Called Board Meeting for approval. December 16, 2021 Post Innovation Plan on district website for at least 30 days runs through January 16, 2022. The District will send TEA Commissioner notice of approval of the plan and all other TEA required information (completed within 15 days after the board approves).

OVERVIEW

AMENDMENT OR RENEWAL OF LOCAL INNOVATION PLAN. A local innovation plan may be amended, rescinded, or renewed if the action is approved TEC by a vote of the district-level committee established under Section 11.251, or a comparable §12A.007 committee if the district is exempt from that section, and the board of trustees in the same manner as required for initial adoption of a local innovation plan under Section 12A 005. (a) A district innovation plan may be amended, rescinded, or renewed if the action is approved by a majority vote of the district-level committee established under the Texas Education Code (TEC), §11.251, or a comparable committee if the district is exempt from 19 TAC that section, and a two-thirds majority vote of the board of trustees §102.1313 (b) The district shall notify the commissioner of education of any actions taken pursuant to subsection (a) of this section along with the associated TEC exemptions and local approval dates.

A designated District of Innovation may choose to amend or renew its plan at any time pursuant to applicable sections of Texas Education Code (TEC) and Texas Administrative Code (TAC). The processes for amending and renewing a plan are different, however. Please see the information below.

Amendment

19 TAC §102.1313(a) (1) Amendment. An amendment to an approved plan does not change the date of the term of designation as an innovation district. Exemptions that were already formally approved are not required to be reviewed.

- An amendment may be made to a DOI plan at any time during the term of the plan.
- An amendment to a DOI plan does not require the district to repeat the adoption process in its entirety (see "Process Requirements" chart on page 2).
- An amendment to a DOI plan does not change the date of the term of the plan; the original adopted term must remain the same.

Renewal

(3) Renewal. During renewal, all sections of the plan and exemptions shall be reviewed 19 TAC and the district must follow all components outlined in §102.1307 of this title (relating to §102.1313(a) Adoption of Local Innovation Plan).

- A DOI plan may be renewed at any time during the term of the plan.
- A district may only have one innovation plan at any given time (19 TAC §102.1311). As such, a renewed
 plan takes effect only after the term of the district's current innovation plan expires. In the instance that
 the district intends for the term of a renewed plan to begin prior to the expiration of its current plan, the
 renewed plan supersedes the district's current plan at that time and the current plan is considered void.
- The district must repeat the adoption process outlined in 19 TAC §102,1207, however 2 specific steps
 are not required to be repeated (see "Process Requirements" chart on page 2).
- The term of the DOI plan may be extended for up to an additional 5 years during renewal.
