Description: Each full day coaching session includes up to 6 hours of coaching and support on how to integrate Evidence-Based Practices in the classroom by an expert Easterseals Autism Specialist. Illinois Autism Partnership coaching tools will be used to provide feedback and support to each classroom.

Description: Each full day of VBMAPP support coaching will include up to 6 hours of coaching and support on how to integrate the VBMAPP into daily programming and ongoing assessment. An expert Illinois Autism Partnership coach will help facilitate collaborative IEP team discussions, support data collection and data-based decision-making, and provide ongoing feedback and review of the implementation of VBMAPP in the district. Coach will work closely with school teams and district administrators to ensure consistency across buildings.

Total Coaching Days: 27 (18 traditional coaching days - 2 per month, 9 VBMAPP Support coaching - 1 per month)



Terms & Conditions

This agreement is established on between Easterseals' Illinois Autism Partnership and <u>Antioch</u> <u>School District 34.</u> The contents of this agreement describe the district's obligation for payment of identified services and also includes an outline of Illinois Autism Partnership's deliverables.

The Illinois Autism Partnership facilitates engagement with families and provides individualized support to school districts and community organizations through a variety of methods, including training, professional development, coaching, and consulting. The goal of this partnership is to work in collaboration with districts and organizations to create positive and sustainable outcomes for individuals with autism and other related disabilities.

The Illinois Autism Partnership will work with community organizations to increase the implementation of evidence-based practices. Please refer to page one for an overview of the total service cost.

Mutual Obligations:

- Indemnification
 - Each party to this Agreement agrees that they shall hold harmless, indemnify and defend the other party, its shareholders, directors, officers, agents, and employees against any and all claims, causes of action, injuries and damages including, but not limited to, personal injury and property damage, of the other party, its agents, contractors or employees.

District/Cooperative/Agency Obligations:

- Payment Terms
 - Payment and signature of the contract by the district/school/agency will confirm Easterseals agreement to provide the services within the mutually agreed upon timeframe.
 - See page one for a description of the total costs associated with this contract.
 - Please remit payment within two weeks of the final invoice.
- <u>Insurance</u>
 - Please provide Easterseals with a copy of the agency/district/school's insurance.
- <u>Personnel</u>
 - Agreement from general and special education administrators on implementation of the initiatives identified.
 - Inclusion of a district or school coach or other key personnel to participate in scheduled onsite activities.
- <u>Cancellation</u>
 - Provide two weeks' advance notice for any cancellation or changes in service dates, with the exception of emergency closures.
 - Extended School Closures: Ensure opportunities for virtual participation in modified coaching or professional development sessions as contracted, choose mutually agreed upon dates within the fiscal year (July to June), or elect to retain a district credit for services with Easterseals' Illinois Autism Partnership in the upcoming school year.



- <u>Travel</u>
 - Provide payment for all associated travel expenses, including mileage, hotel, and/or meals when identified in advance as a requirement for delivery of the contractual services.

Illinois Autism Partnership Obligations:

- <u>Technical Assistance</u>
 - Provide all services as outlined on page one of this contract.
 - Use practices aligned with the current evidence-based research recommended for educating students with disabilities.
 - o Coordinate delivery of services with the district.
 - Develop and share a service delivery plan with the district outlining key details, including:
 - Dates of service
 - Times of services
 - Identification of the type of service
 - Training topics, as applicable
 - Provide advance notice for any cancellation or changes in services dates.
 - o Work with the district to reschedule canceled services, if/when necessary.
- <u>Coaches</u>
 - Provide coaches that are knowledgeable of current special education practices and experienced in implementing evidence-based practices.
 - o Assign coaches to the district for implementation of the services.
 - Coaches are employees of Easterseals and are not entitled to any benefits from the district or school.
 - Coaches are required to report any suspicions of abuse or neglect to the Department of Child and Family Services hotline.

This contract may be canceled by either party with thirty days written notice.

By signing and accepting below you are acknowledging that you have read and agree to the specific terms outlined in this document and wish to proceed with the implementation of the aforementioned services.
