ADDITIONS

CONSENT TO PROVIDE A MENTAL HEALTH CARE SERVICE

• State law requires districts to include procedures for recommending interventions as well as identifying the district's mental health liaison.

CONSENT TO RECORD A STUDENT

• Notice to parents that permission is required prior to making an audio or video recording or still images of classroom activities.

SPECIAL EDUCATION REFERRALS

• TEA requests that districts provide the contact information for the SPED post secondary transition and employment designee.

ADDITIONS

FAFSA or TASFA

• Beginning with the 2021-22 school year, students enrolled in grade 12 must complete a FAFSA or TASFA before graduating from high school.

PROMOTION & RETENTION

• Describes the ACT/SAT requirements when students complete high school end-of-course assessments prior to high school.

REMOTE INSTRUCTION

Reminds students and parents that local and state policies also apply to remote instruction.

ADDITIONS

STUDENT ILLNESS

 Recommends asking parents to contact the school nurse in the case of COVID-19 diagnosis or symptoms.

VIDEO CAMERAS

• Added language to align our handbook with FL(LEGAL).

CAFETERIA

 Informs parents of the Child Nutrition waiver provided by the USDA.

Deletions

STAAR TESTING

• HB 3906 eliminates the stand-alone writing assessments for grades 4 and 7 beginning with the 2021–2022 school year

ATTENDANCE

• Revised the text to remove language added as a result of the attendance practices specific to the pandemic.

TRANSPORTATION

 Removed the sections related to Bus Student Access Card Program. Bus access cards are now a part of student ID cards.
