### Illinois School Report Card Details

- School Report Cards issued annually to all public schools from Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE)
- ISBE assigns each school with a "Summative Designation" reflecting relative performance to other schools across the state
- In addition to Summative Designations, School Report Cards include substantial school-related data about a variety of topics



### Summative Designation Categories (K-8)

#### Exemplary:

Overall performance in top 10% of schools, with no underperforming student groups at or below the "all students" group of the lowest-performing 5 percent of schools

#### Commendable:

Overall performance not in top 10% of schools; no underperforming student groups at or below the "all students" group of the lowest-performing 5 percent of schools

- Targeted Support
- Comprehensive Support
- Intensive Support



A school's annual summative designation describes how well an individual school is meeting the needs of all its students. The designations recognize schools with strong overall performance across a range of academic and student success indicators. Schools with greatest need receive the most support.


#### Academic Indicators

- 6. English Learner Progress to Proficiency: 5%






# Accountability Indicators

- Summative Designations are calculated by assigning points for every accountability indicator
- The indicators are weighed, meaning that each indicator is worth a different number of total possible points
- Schools are then ranked by points to find the threshold for the bottom 5% (Comprehensive Support) and top 10% (Exemplary)
- The remaining 85% schools are Commendable or Targeted Support, if they have a low performing student group
- The points threshold changes yearly according to the statewide data




2025 -Weighted Index Score ▼




