#### **GREAT THINGS CONTINUE TO HAPPEN IN HSA!**

As we approach the Thanksgiving holidays, the HSA team is grateful for all that has been accomplished this semester. A culture of excellence continues to permeate throughout our HSA Center—you can sense it, feel it, and see it!

Our EOC intervention plans, along with student engagement in Edgenuity and the Capturing Kids' Hearts (CKH) program, continue to yield great success. Many of our students have exceeded their pacing calendar goals, and those who have not are very close to doing so.

Offering the program twice a day continues to allow us to support more students and to maximize their learning opportunities.

The excitement our students display about their success is truly rewarding to see and hear. To be at this point in the year where we can celebrate what's working is both humbling and inspiring!

#### **ACADEMIC PROGRESS & GRADUATION DATA**

Every day, we continue making strides to ensure our students are prepared for the futures they choose.

- November 2025 Graduates: 6 students
- **December 2025 Graduates:** 9 students
- Total Goal for 2025–2026 School Year: 70–75 graduates

This total will represent approximately **16% of the district's overall graduation rate** for 2025–2026.

As we reach the halfway mark of the school year, we continue to **celebrate what's working and refine what's not**. Each student receives multiple opportunities to succeed through individualized support.

We have disaggregated our EOC data and developed targeted, individualized instructional plans for every December re-tester. Most of our students are now EOC complete. Instruction and preparation remain key this month as we propel our students toward the finish line.

"This program is a good program, and it helps so many students who wouldn't be able to graduate without it. The students are lucky to be in HSA."

We are truly grateful for Ms. Terrell's heart for service, her steadfast dedication, and the love she pours into every student who walks through our doors. She is an essential part of what makes HSA such a special place.

## HSA Staff and Community Step Up to Support Students in Need

In October, the **Hornet Success Academy staff** came together to give hope and support to several students facing significant life challenges. When one student lost his caregiver and became homeless, the HSA team—along with community partners—immediately stepped in to provide **shelter**, **food**, **toiletries**, **clothing**, **and other essentials** to ensure these students could continue their education and stay on track to graduate.

Thanks to this outpouring of compassion and teamwork, each of these students is now moving forward toward graduation:

- One student will graduate in January 2026
- Two students will graduate in April 2026

## **Joey Cassard**

Joey is a resilient student who became homeless after being abandoned by his parents last year. He joined HSA in November and is on track to graduate in **April 2026**. Joey plans to become an **electrician** after graduation. HSA Director **Sharonda Johnson** is working closely with **Reliant Energy** to help Joey enroll in **lineman school**, opening the door to a promising career path.

#### **Corey Lavan**

Corey plans to attend **Tulsa Welding School** after graduation. Before joining HSA, he earned his **welding certification** in high school but took a year off to cope with personal loss. Upon returning to the district, Corey joined HSA and has since expressed deep gratitude for the second chance the program has given him. "**HSA was an answer to my prayer**," he shared. A generous community member has volunteered to purchase his **welding gear and boots** when he begins school in Tulsa.



#### Mia Valdez

Mia took a year away from school to work full-time and care for her young son and two siblings after her parents were deported. Despite her challenges, she returned determined to finish her education and build a stable future for her family. Mia will graduate from HSA in April 2026 and plans to begin a career with the Texas Department of Criminal Justice (TDCJ).

We are deeply appreciative of this ongoing partnership with SHSU and the positive impact it continues to make on our students' growth, confidence, and future success.
















#### HSA STAFF PREPARE STUDENTS FOR DECEMBER EOC TESTING:

The primary goal of the **Hornet Success Academy (HSA)** is to help students become **EOC complete** or **IGC eligible** before graduating from HSA. Teachers and staff work together to prepare an individual educational plan for each student who enters our program to ensure when they graduate, students are fully prepared to enter the *workforce*, *military*, *trade school*, *or post-secondary institutions*.

Over the past four years, 95% of HSA students graduate within one year of entering the program. Most students arrive at HSA needing to pass one or more End-of-Course (EOC) assessments, but through individualized instruction, targeted interventions, and a strong support system, they gain the tools and confidence needed to reach their academic and career goal











