We did get our bobcat/forklift, the shop has been getting all of our winter equipment ready for the winter months.

So, for the office department, they have been busy with billing and getting to know the new time clock plus. They are getting all drivers to gather all bus route milage so we can get bus reimbursement submitted and we will also be doing our bus evacuation, which is a state requirement.

So, for the disciplinary department, we have 38 write ups, and 7 removals. Once again most are happening when buses are over crowded due to losing to many drivers on a trips, but were going to improve with bus monitors aboard.
