Goal/Objective	Crosby ISD District Improvement Plan Goal #1: Crosby Independent
Addressed	School District will make academic achievement and student
	performance its priority.
Background	Each year, Texas public school districts are required to adopt a calendar
	that provides a minimum of 75,600 minutes of operational time for
	students. The Texas Education Agency also recognizes the importance
	for educators to receive meaningful, up-to-date professional development. Therefore, TEA is providing school districts the
	opportunity to apply for a Staff Development Waiver (that provides for a
	maximum of 2,100 minutes) that can be used in place of instructional
	time yet still contribute toward the 75,600 minute requirement.
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	The provisions of this waiver will be used to assist Crosby ISD in meeting
	the 75,600 minute requirement. Further, an approved waiver by
	TEA will provide Crosby ISD with additional minutes that can be applied
	if/when the District is closed on normally scheduled operational days for
	reasons such as inclement weather.
	Included below is further explanation of the Staff Development Waiver
	option provided by the Texas Education Agency:
	This waiver allows the district and charter schools to train staff on
	various educational strategies designed to improve student
	performance in lieu of student instruction during the school year.
	Effective with the 2018-19 school year, the Staff Development
	Minutes Waiver provides for a maximum of 2,100 total waiver

minutes to use for professional development for districts and charter schools that provide operational and instructional minutes.

Each district and open-enrollment charter school may choose how to apply their approved *Staff Development Minutes Waiver*. For instance, schools may choose to offer early release, late start, all day staff development, or a combination. However, the total waiver minutes for staff development shall not exceed 2,100 minutes per year.

This waiver is for staff development in place of student instruction; therefore, the waiver minutes are only applicable to staff development provided instead of student instruction during the school year. Effective with the 2018-19 school year, the *Staff Development Minutes Waiver* may not be used prior to the first day of student instruction or after the last day of student instruction.

On staff development days when students are in attendance part of the day, in order to receive full ADA funding, the district or open-enrollment charter school must provide at least 120 minutes of student instruction. *Instructional* minutes are defined in the SAAH as the portion of the school day in which instruction takes place along with other exceptions. In addition to the 120 minutes of student instruction, any staff development waiver minutes reported must reflect actual staff development minutes provided.

Upon approval, Crosby ISD will complete and submit the TEA Staff Development Minutes Waiver for the 2025-26 and 2026 - 27 school year when the waiver portal is available.

Note: Effective with the 2025–2026 school year, districts and openenrollment charter schools that are four-day-school-week LEAs are not eligible to receive a staff development waiver. Crosby ISD has contacted TEA and is awaiting a response for clarification of a 4-day hybrid calendar qualification. Crosby ISD will complete the approval process pending TEA's determination of distinguishing if the district qualifies for the waiver under the hybrid 4-day instructional calendar.
