Fall Sports (Cross Country / Volleyball / Football)

Volleyball & Football

Our athletic teams have been very competitive throughout the season. The 8th grade volleyball team, along with the 7th and 8th grade football teams finished undefeated and hosted their prospective district tournament/championship games.

On Saturday, October 4th, we hosted the 8th grade girls district at Homedale High School and our 7th grade team traveled to Fruitland Middle School for the 7th grade tournament. Both teams competed very hard. The 8th grade ended up finishing 2nd and the 7th grade team ended up with a 3rd place finish in each tournament.

On Wednesday, October 8th, we hosted both the 7th and 8th grade district football championship games. Both games were very competitive and all teams played very hard. The 8th grade team beat a very tough Fruitland team and were crowned champions. The 7th grade team came up a little short giving them a 2nd place finish in the district.

Cross Country

Our cross country team has been performing very well. They recently competed in the Gibb Floyd meet in Kuna. This race was a full 5K, just like the high school competitions.
