ABSENCES & TARDIES:

Fruitdale Elementary School and Three Rivers School District believe that regular timely attendance is the most critical investment you can make in your student's academic growth and achievement. If your child is absent please call the school to inform us of the absence. If you know in advance that your child will be absent, please inform the office prior to the scheduled absence. School starts at 7:40 AM.

The front doors open at 7:15 AM. Please do not send your child to school before 7:15. There is no supervision prior to that time. Students should be in their classroom ready to learn at 7:40 AM. Any student who arrives to school after 7:40 AM is considered tardy. Children who walk into class late are at a disadvantage because they've missed important instructional time. Tardies decrease class instructional time and productivity. Please plan with

your child to make getting out the door in the mornings easier.

School gets out at 1:55 PM. If you are picking up your child, please be here on time. There is no supervision after school. If you need to make different arrangements for your child to go home from school, please send a note with your child in the morning or call the school before 1:30 so we can get the message to your child.
