If reasonable attempts to dispose of surplus properties fail to produce a monetary return to the district, the Board may dispose of them in another manner.

If the district property was purchased with state, federal or private grant funds disposal of the property shall be made as outlined in the grant or by state or federal regulations.

## **Disposal of District Property**

The district shall make every reasonable effort to secure sources for disposal of surplus materials that are in the best financial interest of the district. If these attempts to dispose of individual surplus items of \$500.00 or more fail to produce a monetary return to the district, unsold materials may then, at the superintendent's or designee's discretion, be disposed of as scrap or junk, or be donated to appropriate charitable or educational agencies.

Individual district-owned items that are irreparable, obsolete, surplus, unwanted and/or excessively damaged and carry an estimated value of less than \$500.00 may be disposed of by the district at the discretion of the superintendent and/or designee.

Real property owned by the district shall be sold only by Board resolution.

If the district property was purchased with state, federal or private grant funds disposal of the property shall be made as outlined in the grant or by state or federal regulations.

The superintendent shall develop procedures for the specific guidelines associated with the disposal of district property.
