Background: The Texas Education Association conducted Intruder Detection Audits at one or more of our campuses. The audits test whether a campus is accessible to an unauthorized individual. These audits help identify how we can improve safety for our students, such as ensuring exterior doors are closed and locked. We are working closely with our campus administrators and maintenance department to ensure we are training all our staff and securing our doors for the protection of everyone at our campuses. Intruder Detection Audits are just one of the many actions we are taking to ensure our schools are safe. Specific details of the Intruder Detection Audit reports and corrective actions were discussed in executive session.
