NSBSD Strategic Plan Goal:

Issue Summary:

The NSBSD Board Finance Committee met on October 23, 2020 to discuss the Fiscal Year 2021-2022 budget planning among other needs of the District and determined to collaborate between the governing Borough's Budget committee to ensure transparency, accountability, and efficiency between organizations allowing for an improved relationship and financial stewardship of the Borough and the District.

With the State's continued Budget deficit and reduction in State Program Funding surrounding Education (i.e. suspension of the School Debt Reimbursement Program, forward funding, and reductions in other educational programs) amongst other legislation that may impact the Borough's operations, it is in the best interest of the District and the Borough to formulate a closer collaboration in an effort to streamline operations and maximize its financial resources to better meet the needs of the Borough and School District.

In addition, considering the level of funding provided to the District by the Borough, it will be beneficial to schedule quarterly meetings to discuss District needs and provide an overview of the operations and finances of the District.
