### **Discipline Report (previous month)**

Saralynn Hook is working intensively with students in grades 7-8 with Restorative Practices.

February (5 7th, 9 8th, 12 fr, 4 so, 4 jr, 2 sr). Twelve were suspended for profanity to staff (2 7th, 2 8th, 7 fr, 1 so), 11 for blatant defiance, mostly involving electronic devices (3 fr, 3 so, 3 jr, 2 sr), 3 for possession/use marijuana (2 8th, 1 jr), 2 for assault (1 7th, 1 8th), 2 for breaking and entering (2 8th), 3 for property damage (1 7th, 1 8th, 1 fr), 1 for dangerous items (7th), 1 for endangerment (8th), and 1 for threats to staff (9th).

In lieu of OSS for chronically disruptive/defiant students, 25 students were assigned mandatory parent escorts of varying lengths (21 7th, 4 8th, 1 so).
