


Early Childhood Continuing Education

Congratulations to 3 of our Roots and Branches staff members who graduated with their Associates degree in Early Childhood over the past week, two from Northwood Technical College and one from Northwest Technical College. Two will continue their pursuit of their Bachelors degree at UW Whitewater and one will continue at NWTC for her Administrative Credential in Early Childhood. Currently, additional staff members are in various education programs at Northwood Tech, NWTC, University of Minnesota, and UW Eau Claire. By fall, 12 staff members will be actively pursuing higher education certifications and degrees.

<u>District to Partner with WI</u> Reading Corps

The District has developed a partnership with Reading Corps to have two reading tutors onsite next year working 1:1 with students in grades K-3.
