C. Strategic Objective, Goal, or Need Addressed:

Grading Guidelines require all students to take a semester exam at the end of the Spring semester for Yearlong Courses and at the end of all One Semester Courses. Students who do not meet exemption requirements will take a semester exam in each course.

D. Summary:

During one-semester courses and the spring semester, yearlong courses students will be eligible for exam exemptions.

Students in grades 9-12 may be exempt from the semester exam in each course if the following criteria are met:

- The student has maintained an average of 85 or higher during the semester in the course for which the exemption is granted.
- The student has no more than three unexcused absences in the course for which the exemption is granted.

The date range consists of the following:

August 19, 2019- December 4, 2019 - for students taking a one-semester course in the Fall January 9, 2020- May 13, 2020- for students taking one Semester Course taken in the Spring August 19, 2019 - May 13, 2020 - for Yearlong Courses
