SAFETY PROGRAM PROTOCOL

JUNE 20, 1988

The administration shall attempt to prevent accidents from occurring by taking reasonable precautions to protect the safety of all students, employees, visitors and others present on District property or at school-sponsored events.

It is the responsibility of the administrative staff to assure the safety of children while under the supervision of School District employees.

The staff shall adhere to recommended safety practices as they pertain to the school plants buildings and grounds, special areas of instruction, student transportation, school sports activities, occupational safety, etc.

Each school's principal or designated leading administrator shall be responsible for the supervision of a safety program for his/her school, including adherence to the safety drill requirements per state law. The superintendent or superintendent's designee shall have overall responsibility for the safety program of the District. The superintendent or superintendent's designee shall see that inform appropriate staff members are kept informed of current state and local requirements relating to fire prevention, civil defense, sanitation, public health, and occupational safety protocols.
