## BUSINESS MANAGEMENT SAFETY PROGRAM **PROTOCOL**

~~JUNE 20, 1988~~

The administration shall attempt to prevent accidents from occurring by taking reasonable precautions to protect the safety of all students, employees, visitors and others present on District property or at school-sponsored events.

It is the responsibility of the administrative staff to assure the safety of children while under the supervision of School District employees.

The staff shall adhere to recommended safety practices as they pertain to the school plants **buildings and grounds**, special areas of instruction, student transportation, school ~~sports~~ **activities**, occupational safety, etc.

Each **school's** principal **or designated leading administrator** shall be responsible for the supervision of a safety program for his/her school, **including adherence to the safety drill requirements per state law**. The superintendent or **superintendent's** designee shall have overall responsibility for the safety program of the District. The superintendent or **superintendent's** designee shall ~~see that~~ **inform** appropriate staff members ~~are kept informed~~ of current state and local requirements relating to fire prevention, civil defense, sanitation, public health, and ~~occupational safety~~ **protocols**.
