The CTE department is requesting board approval to allow UISD to offer the following state-innovative course at Lyndon B. Johnson High School beginning in the 2026-2027 school year.

Students enrolled in this new Program of Study will have the option to have work-based learning opportunities with various community partners, including the Kazen Fellowship Program.
