Re: Out of District Limited Schools of Choice

The 105 and 105c Schools of Choice program has been utilized to offset our declining enrollment and increase our revenue since the 2014-2015 school year. During the 2021-2022 school year, we enrolled 91 students for roughly an additional \$791,000 in revenue.

For the 2022-2023 school year, we are recommending offering up to 195 total seats through the 105 and 105c Schools of Choice program. In K-8, we would offer up to 185 seats. Both CAPA and Global Education will have up to 5 seats each. This is the same as what we offered for the current school year. We could anticipate roughly \$1,000,000 in revenue for the 2022-2023 school year. The application window would be March 1, 2022 – March 31, 2022, at 4:00 pm.
