Band - Ron Chapman

The AHS band program continues to thrive as the year rolls along. Since the last notes to the board, the band has competed at UIL Area contest in marching band. The band has worked extremely hard preparing for this every other year contest. The planning began in January of 2012 for the contest in November. Our music was specially selected and written for us. The band's drill was once again prepared by Mr. Chapman during May through August.

The band earned 8th place during the preliminary competition out of twenty four bands. This was good enough to make the top 10 and Finals. The evening of October 27th, the band returned and moved up one place to eventually place 7th.

Of the 10 judges that judged the band the scores for the day ranged from 2nd overall to 11th. In Finals, one judge had us 2nd overall. We are very close to being able to compete with the big boys. Four bands (Argyle, Wills Point, Princeton and Canton) have made the trip from Area to state every time in the last decade. We are doing very well in the face of the new 3A competition though, but will have to ask for more if we are going to have any chance of breaking in to state 2 years from now. The top 4 bands from our Area all were top 7 bands at the State Marching Contest. This is *always* the situation with bands from our Area competing at the State Contest.

I did an interesting survey on band budgets of the bands we were asked to compete against at Area. The annual Aubrey band budget is less than 1/3rd the average of the 24 bands competing at this year's Area contest. In comparing the band budgets of the 24 schools at Area, we were ranked last. Our band budget is 11,000K less than the 23rd ranked budget. The top four bands average budget exceeds \$180,000 on an <u>annual</u> basis -after taking budget cuts. Two bands yearly budget exceeds \$200,000 (Not Argyle!). A total report is available through Mr. Mulkey and Dr. Monaco.

Last Saturday the band took 17 students to All Region tryouts. The band placed 10 students in the All Region band and has 2 students that advance to Area with a strong chance of getting to state this year. We have also placed another 10 students in the middle school All Region Band.

The band MS Christmas concert will be Tuesday, December 11th at 6:30 in the MS cafeteria. The HS and 6th grade concert will be December 13th at 6:30pm in the HS Gym. We would invite all board members out to hear our kids play great Christmas music.

As always, the directors at AHS are extremely proud of the support we have in and outside of the classroom. We appreciate all the support that the board and administration shows on a day in, day out basis!

The UIL Academics team travelled to Center High School in November and came away victorious with 16 different awards.

To follow this great performance, we hosted a successful tournament at the end of the month with 19 schools and nearly 200 students competing in speaking, debating, and testing events.
