Re: Seating New Board

Every two years, members of the community run for election to serve their local school boards. This year, four seats were up for election in Lincolnshire-Prairie View District 103. Three members returned to the Board and one new member is joining the district due to a retiring board member. The newly elected members are:

The process for seating the board members includes administering the oath of office, which states the duties each board member must uphold, the election of the officers, which include the president, vice president, secretary, and treasurer and the approval of the board meeting schedule for the new school year.

Beginning in the 2025–2026 school year, the Board of Education will welcome two 8th-grade student representatives from Daniel Wright Junior High School. These students will serve as non-voting members and will not attend closed session meetings. Their role will be to provide valuable student perspectives on school and district matters, helping to ensure student voices are represented in Board discussions.

Following the seating of the new board, there will be a reception honoring Kate Harper for her retirement and celebrating the election of the returning and new board members.
