2020 Engagement Update

Board Goal:

Domain 3 – Growth & Management

- Demonstrate effective and efficient management of district resources
- Provide leadership and/or oversight to ensure District meets all fiscal, legal and regulatory requirements.

Purpose of Report:

The purpose of this report is to provide the Board of Trustees with a summary of Denton ISD's student engagement during the first 8 days of the 2020-2021 school year.

Objective:

The objective is to closely monitor the engagement numbers as identified by Connected Learners and Face to Face students.

Operational Impact:

The analysis of Denton ISD's enrollment data allows the district to monitor student engagement based upon learning platform selected by campus and grade level.

Results

As of Day 6, September 2, 2020, Denton ISD has a total of 29,513 total students that have demonstrated engagement. This is 13,289 elementary students and 16,224 secondary students. Of the 29,513 students 11,588 of these students have selected "Connected Learning" and engaged through either Canvas or Seesaw during these six instructional days.

September 8, 2020 Denton ISD is expecting 7,998 elementary students across all campuses to engage through face to face instruction, with 9,927 secondary students to begin face to face learning on a hybrid schedule.
