

SAMPLE POLICY

TRANSFER REQUESTS

A nonresident student shall not be permitted to attend District schools except as provided below.

EXCEPTIONS

A nonresident student that is currently transferring into District Schools will be grandfathered and will be eligible to continue until they have graduated.

A student whose parents have a contract on a house or a builders contract to build a house in the District may be allowed to enroll in District schools for up to 120 calendar days, but will be required to pay tuition fees until the student is a legal resident of the District. After the initial 120 days, the student will be asked to withdraw.

A resident student who becomes a nonresident during the course of a semester shall be permitted to continue in attendance for the remainder of the semester.

A nonresident employee may request that his or her child be admitted into District schools by filing an application with the Superintendent or designee. Transfers shall be granted for one regular school year at a time, on a tuition-free basis.

In approving transfers, the Superintendent or designee shall consider availability of space and instructional staff and the student's disciplinary history and attendance records.

FACTORS APPEALS

Any appeals shall be made in accordance with FNG(LOCAL) and GF(LOCAL), as appropriate.
