Early Childhood

- The Early Interventionist position is posting and we are anxiously awaiting the opportunity to enhance our 0-3 team supporting Early On and Early Childhood Special Education Home-based services.
- 0-3 Data Update(from July 1, 2018 to present):
 - Referrals processed- 119
 - 0-3 Students currently served: 83
- Ready, Set, Go PLAY (playgroup) will begin the first week of February. This playgroup focuses on providing an opportunity for our home-based students who will transition to a preschool classroom, to come get experience with same age peers and develop an understanding of what preschool is about. This will support our youngest students' success as they transition to the school environment. This group is lead by Early Childhood Special Education Teacher, Stephanie Hines, and supported by our Primary Service Provider team.
- Our Early Childhood Special Education Preschool teachers are beginning to start transition preparations. They are beginning to talk to parents about where their students will attend Preschool or Kindergarten, and reaching out to these programs to begin discussions, offer classroom observations/visits and generally support a successful transition for all.
