Emergency Drills

Each Elementary and Secondary campus performs the following drills every year:

- Communications Drill
- Building Evacuation (Fire Drills)
- Lockdown Drills
- Weather Shelter Drill
- Site Evacuation
- Reverse Evacuation
- Bomb Threat Drill
- Shelter in Place

State Mandated Security Audits

Every building in the district is audited every three years using the following format:

- Entrance Conference Questionnaire
- Building Administrator's Conference – 16 factors
- Monitoring, Surveillance, Communication – 15 factors
- Building Grounds, Exterior, Access, Portable Buildings – 38 factors
- Building Interior – 45 factors

- Building Interior, Secondary Science Labs – 24 factors
- Intruder Assessment
- All staff safety review – 18 questions

At the end of every three-year cycle, the results of the audits are shared with the Board in closed session. An online report is sent to the Texas School Safety Center.
